

THA COVID-19 UPDATE

Your family's health is very important to us! The Tuscaloosa Housing Authority (THA) is taking actions to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). We are closely following the recommendations provided by the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH), the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the City of Tuscaloosa.

THA is taking the following actions to prevent the spread of the disease:

- THA is limiting all face-to-face interactions. Please do not visit our offices unless necessary. Instead, please contact us by phone or email (phone numbers provided below).
- THA is closing all community rooms and computer labs.
- THA is postponing all THA-sponsored events.
- THA is suspending all interior pest control service.
- THA is suspending all interior preventive maintenance activities.

We respectfully request that our residents take the following actions to prevent the spread of disease:

- Please stay at home if you or a family member is sick.
- Please avoid social gatherings and practice social distancing.
- Please wash your hands with warm water and soap for at least 20 seconds several times per day.
- Please do not visit THA offices unless necessary. Instead, please contact THA by phone or email.
- If you call in a work order, please indicate whether you or someone in your household is sick or experiencing flu-like symptoms.
- Please pay your rent online or by mail, if possible.
- Please keep your unit as clean and sanitary as possible.
- Please look out for your neighbors. Please call your property manager if you observe an unmet need in your community, and we'll do our best to connect you with available resources.
- Please stay informed!
