Attention Residents:

- The Tuscaloosa Housing Authority main office and all site offices are closed to the public until further notice. Please call your property manager or the main office for assistance.
- Please continue to pay rent on time, and submit your rent payment online or by mail, if possible. If you lose your job or have reduced wages as a result of the COVID-19 crisis, please inform your property manager so your rent can be adjusted accordingly.
- Please be aware that, due to safety precautions, our maintenance department will only address emergency work orders until further notice.
- Please comply with the city's 24-hour curfew order, which includes no social gatherings. The Tuscaloosa Police Department will be strictly enforcing.
- If you or a family member test positive for COVID-19, we ask that you inform your property manager immediately. This information will remain confidential, and will allow us to ensure everyone's safety.
